No firearms with magazines over 10 rounds are permitted. Prohibition does not include firearms with an attached tubular device which is capable of holding only .22LR rimfire ammunition.

Rifles

Must be minimum age of 21 to purchase and must complete and sign in triplicate and deliver to transferring FFL, an "Application to Purchase Shotgun or Rifle."

Full-time, active-duty law enforcement, active-duty military, or National Guard are exempt.

Shotguns

Must be minimum age of 21 to purchase and must complete and sign in triplicate and deliver to transferring FFL, an "Application to Purchase Shotgun or Rifle."

Full-time, active-duty law enforcement, active-duty military, or National Guard are exempt.

Receivers and Frames

No person shall manufacture, sell, offer to sell, transfer, purchase, possess, or have under his or her control a ghost gun or an undetectable firearm produced by a 3D printing process.

"Ghost gun" means a firearm, including a frame or receiver, that lacks a unique serial number engraved or cased in metal alloy on the frame or receiver by a licensed manufacturer, maker or importer under federal law or markings in accordance with 27 C.F.R SS. 479.102.

"Undetectable firearm" means any firearm that: after removal of all parts, other than as a major component, is not as detectable by walk-through metal detectors commonly used at airports or other

public buildings; or any major component of which, if subjected to inspection by the types of detection devices commonly used at airports or other public buildings for security screening, would not generate an image that accurately depicts the shape of the component; or upon which the frame or receiver lacks a unique serial number engraved or cased into on the frame or receiver by a licensed manufacturer, maker of importer under federal law, or markings in accordance with 27 C>F>R. SS. 479.102.

Accessories / Ammunition

Any device, component, part, combination of parts, attachment, or accessory that increases the rate of fire of any firearm, including but not limited to bump stocks, trigger cranks, and binary trigger systems is prohibited.

Prohibited: Any large-capacity feeding device defined as a magazine, box, drum, tube, belt, feed strip, or other ammunition feeding device capable of holding or readily extended to hold more than ten (10) rounds of ammunition to be fed continuously and directly therefrom into a semi-automatic firearm. The term "large-capacity feeding device" does not include an attached tubular device which is capable of holding only .22LR rimfire ammunition.

Full-time active law enforcement, retired law enforcement who possess a permit to carry, and active duty member of armed forces or National Guard who are authorized to possess and carry such a feeding device are exempt.

Must be age 21 to purchase ammunition (includes primed case, propellant or projectile). After December 31, 2022, a purchaser must also possess a valid pistol/revolver safety certificate, OR Rhode Island hunter education course card issued by the Dept. of Environmental Management.

Full-time active law enforcement and active duty military or National Guard are exempt.

Active LE Officers are exempt.
