WARNINGS

Do not use this derringer until you have completely read this instruction manual. We strongly recommend that you seek competent firearms instruction before attempting to use this gun. Failure to follow these gun safety instructions may result in injury or death to you or another.

WARNINGS

- 1. ALWAYS use proper shooting glasses to prevent eye injury!
- 2. ALWAYS use hearing protection to prevent ear damage!
- 3. Never carry a gun loaded while walking, or climbing or anywhere you might slip and fall, dropping the gun. A gun that is dropped, bumped or jarred with a live round in the chamber it might accidentally discharge even with the safety on causing injury to you or someone else.
- Never carry a loaded gun in a motor vehicle and never carry a loaded gun into a dwelling.

- Never rely on the safety to prevent accidental discharge. The safety may not prevent an accidental discharge due to dropping, jarring or bumping of the gun.
- Never alter any part in your gun. Only use Cobra Enterprises replacement parts.
- Only use factory loaded ammunition for which the gun is chambered as indicated on the barrel to prevent excessive pressure and possible serious personal injury.
- Reloaded ammunition can cause serious injury and damage to the firearm due to stress failure and/or excessive pressure.
- Always check the barrel to insure that it is free of obstructions before loading and firing the firearm. If you experience a light recoil or "off" sound. CHECK THE BARREL.

- 10. Never point a gun at anything you do not intend to shoot.
- Always keep your gun pointed in a safe direction while loading and unloading to prevent serious injury in case of accidental discharge.
- Never place your finger on the trigger unless you are ready to shoot.

LOADING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Place hammer in HALF-COCK POSITION, and SAFETY ENGAGED. TO SAFE POSITION.
- Disengage the locking lever by turning forward to the unlocked position.
- 3. Pull the barrel back exposing the breach.
- 4. Insert a cartridge into each chamber. Only use standard factory ammunition that the derringer was chambered for. Do not load or fire reloaded, hot loaded, or plus "P" cartridges. These types of ammunition can be dangerous to you or your derringer.
- Be sure the hammer is still in HALF-COCK position, and SAFETY ENGAGED, lower the barrel into the frame, pointing in a safe direction and re-engage the locking lever to the lock position.

FIRING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Make sure you are wearing your proper hearing and eye protection.
- Make sure that your target is clear of any person or hard surfaces, including water to avoid a ricochet and possible serious injury to yourself or a bystander.
- Point the gun in a safe position while cocking the hammer into the fully cocked position.
- 4. Disengage the safety to the fire position.
- 5. Aim the pistol at your intended target with your finger off the trigger until you are ready to fire.6. Before firing make sure all fingers and hands are away from the

- 7. Once fired the selector automatically selects to the next barrel.
- 8. To fire the other barrel repeat procedures 3, 5 and 6.
- 9. DO NOT DRY FIRE!

UNIONDING INSTRUCTIONS

- Place hammer in HALF-COCK POSITION, and SAFETY ENGAGED, TO SAFE POSITION.
- 2. Disengage the locking lever by turning forward to the unlocked position.
- Pull the barrel back exposing the breach.
- 4. Remove the cartridges by sliding the extractor away from the Barrel allowing you to remove the cartridges from the barrel chambers.

CLEANING

Cobra Enterprises recommends cleaning all guns after use. Avoid using powerful gun solvents. We recommend using WD40 or other similar light oil products.

STORING

AMMUNITION NOTES

- 1. FOR BEST SHOOTING AND FUNCTION WE RECOMMEND FEDERAL, AMERICAN EAGLE AND PMC AMMUNITION (ON ALL COBRA PRODUCTS).
- C-22M Derringer we recommend using Federal .22mag ammunition.
- To load or unload the CB9 you must first push the extractor all the way out and hold it in that position while inserting or removing ammunition.
- Cobra .32 H&R Magnum Derringer is designed to fire Federal .32 H&R Magnum ammunition ONLY.

ALWAYS REMEMBER


- Always keep this derringer in the half-cock hammer position and safety engaged.


