



MS1" Padded Sling


INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS




To connect the sling via sling loop, run the tail end (the end of the sling with two Fit Buckles) of the MS1 through the sling loop on the outside of your rifle stock (the side away from the user when the rifle is slung - to avoid interference) and then back through the Fit Buckles. Double the webbing back through the upper Fit Buckle if possible.

Connect the front end to a sling loop or connector hardware via the same method, lacing the webbing through the front Fit Buckle and doubling back through the buckle.


The MS1° Sling can also be used with any 1-1/4" sling hardware.



Adjust the two ends of the *Padded* section so that it maximizes contact with your shoulder. After you have determined the proper length for your *MS1 Padded Sling*, run the two strap ends back through both the *Rear* and *Middle Fit Buckles* provided.




Double the webbing back through the Fit Buckles if possible to ensure sling is locked in postion.



To adjust for proper fit, make all adjustments on the forward end of the sling where it attaches to the front of the rifle. Adjust the length of the sling so that the *Slider* remains accessible to your non firing hand in the loose position. Once you have made your final adjustments, run the tail back through the *Fit Buckle* and double back and trim if necessary.

NOTE: If you do need to trim the webbing, re-bind the frayed end by melting it with a flame.



To adjust the MS1 Padded Sling while in two-point configuration, simply grab the Slider with your non firing hand and push down to tighten or pull up to loosen the sling.
