# MOUNTING



### Safety First! Unload and make weapon safe!

The M-LOK® direct attachment system features a custom, cammed T-Nut that positions the T-Nut consistently for installation and removal. Simply adjust the gap between the T-Nut and accessory to match the thickness of the mounting surface, align the T-Nuts with the slot, and insert in the desired location. An initial ¼ to ½ turn of the screw for each T-Nut rotates the nut into engagement and then you may tighten normally.







# **INSTALLING BATTERY & ACTIVATING**





To change battery, unscrew the slotted battery door. Insert battery + side towards the top of the unit. IMPORTANT Battery MUST be a wrapped battery. If your battery is not wrapped, the HS1 could short out and become non-operational. Extra batteries can be purchased directly at ViridianWeaponTech.com.

# WINDAGE & ELEVATION ADJUSTMENTS

### See ViridianWeaponTech.com for more detailed instructions and videos

- 1. Unload and make weapon safe.
- 2. Align Viridian® laser to the iron sights of your firearm at the distance that you want to be your zero; between
- 25 feet and 50 yards is suggested.
- 3. Load and fire a 3-shot group at target using the laser to aim.
- 4. Unload and make weapon safe.
- 5. Adjust windage and elevation so that the center point of laser coincides with groupings. To do this, adjust the laser toward the grouping center using the following chart.
- 6. Repeat steps 3 through 5 in order to get alignment.

Use the included Windage/Elevation Tool to adjust the Windage/Elevation of the laser to zero.

Up/Down Adjustments	Clockwise moves laser up. Counterclockwise moves laser down.
Left/Right Adjustments	Clockwise moves laser left. Counterclockwise moves laser right.



# **PRODUCT WARNINGS**

- 1. Before handling any firearm with a Viridian® product, read and understand the entire contents of your firearm manual provided as well as the Viridian® manual, especially the safety precautions and procedures for safe firearm handling.

- 6. The activation buttons on the Viridian® product allows you to operate the laser without placing your finger inside the trigger guard. Always keep your fingers off the trigger and outside the trigger guard until you are ready to fire the weapon.
- 7. Always verify that the chamber of the weapon is empty or "clear" before attempting to mount or dismount the Viridian® product. Follow the "clearing" procedures as set forth in the manual for your firearm.
- 8. Always make sure the firearms is "clear" and on safe before making windage/elevation adjustments.

# PRODUCT WARNINGS CONTINUED

- 9. Failure to follow any of the safety warnings listed when handling a firearm and/or the Viridian® product can be dangerous and can result in serious injury, damage to property, or death.

  10. Do not operate the Viridian® product around cleaning solvents or flammable/combustible materials. Avoid use of the Viridian® product in environments involving a flammable atmosphere or gases, such as evaporated gasoline. ## **MAINTENANCE & CARE**

There are no user serviceable parts in this product and no scheduled maintenance required other than battery replacement. Regular cleaning after each use as outlined below will keep this product performing at its best. This unit is not to be opened or modified by the customer (other than battery replacement), such actions will void your warranty.

#### FRONT LENS CLEANING:

Use a moistened cotton swab to periodically clean the front lens of gun powder residue. This step is important to prevent any degradation in the quality of the aiming point and/or beam.

#### **EXTERIOR OF UNIT:**

Clean the Viridian® product by wiping with a soft, damp cloth. Standard gun cleaning solvents may be used to clean stubborn areas.

#### **ELECTRICAL CONTACTS:**

For cleaning of all electrical contacts, use a cotton swab dipped in alcohol. To remove heavy build-up on the contacts, carefully rub with a standard pencil eraser (be sure to thoroughly remove eraser residue).
