

Gun Warehouse & Range

Range Rules

1. Keep any firearm pointed downrange at ALL times, perpendicular to the target line, whether loaded, unloaded, or malfunctioning. Be sure of the target and what is behind the target.
2. Keep your finger off the trigger and on a fixed point on the side of the frame until you are on target and ready to fire.
3. Do not load the firearm until ready to fire.
4. All guns that are “benched” should be unloaded, action open, and magazine removed.
5. No uncontrolled rapid fire at any time.
6. Under no circumstances may a loaded firearm be passed to another person. A firearm will be considered loaded if a magazine is inserted and/or firearm is in a closed, locked condition.
7. At the command “Cease Fire!” immediately make your firearm “safe,” set the gun down pointed downrange, and step away from the firing line into the safety area with nothing in your hands.
8. Eye and ear protection is MANDATORY at all times.
9. No food, drink, or tobacco use of any kind is permitted on the range, even in range bags, purses etc.
10. Be certain that your ammunition is correct for the firearm you will be shooting.
11. Know and understand how your firearm works and understand operation of all safety features.
12. Never use alcohol, drugs, or other mind-altering substances before or during your range session.
13. Advise range personnel of any medical condition which could create a safety issue for you or others.
14. Collection of *your* brass that falls on shooter's side of the firing line is permitted when your session is over. Under no circumstances may any implement or appendage cross forward of the red firing line.
15. No drawing from holsters without prior permission from on-duty Range Officer.
16. Only one shooter in the shooter's “box” in a lane at a time, all other participants must be behind the safety line.
17. Range Officer decisions or determinations are final. Any misuse of facility or disregard of rules will result in expulsion from the range.
