Usage Instructions

1. Place the unloaded Firearm onto the 7-Rest, resting the forend on the Front Support and the butt in the Rear Support. The stock should extend past the Rear Support.
2. Adjust or reposition the rest laterally to align the firearm's sights with the target. Adjust the height of the front support until the correct elevation is achieved. Course elevation adjustments are easily made by loosening the Adjustment Nut and Knurled Nut, and changing the height of the Front Support. Re-tighten the Adjustment Nut when the correct elevation is attained. The Rear Support can also be employed to raise and lower the rear of the firearm to give added elevation adjustment.
3. Turn the long front leg for fine elevation adjustment. Quick elevation changes can be made by sliding the firearm forward and backward, taking advantage of the shape of your firearm's stock.
4. Use the Knurled Nut on the Long Front Leg to lock the leg into place and eliminate any play.

Note: For best results store the 7-Rest in a clean and dry environment.
