This firearm has been tested using proof and service ammunition that meets Sporting Arms & Ammunition Manufacturers Institute (SAAMI) performance standards.




Before You Use Your Nomad Single Barrel Shotgun

It is very important that you read and understand this manual. Warnings should be read and heeded very carefully. Also study "The Rules for Firearm Safety" in this manual.

•WARNING: Your gun is shipped completely assembled and should not be used or disassembled without fully reading and understanding the instructions in this Owner's Manual.

•WARNING: It is a violation of federal law to alter or deface the serial number of any firearm.







Now with a live round in the gun's chamber while keeping your finger outside the trigger guard draw the hammer rearward with your thumb into the full rearward "cocked position" Photo (D)

Your Nomad single barrel shotgun is now ready to fire. Keep the gun pointed in a safe direction. Be sure of your target and make sure the area beyond your target is safe as well. With the gun properly seated in your shoulder while aiming at your target, push the safety button to the full left "off safe position" Photo (E)

and then and only then when you are sure of your target and the area beyond you should put your finger inside the trigger guard and pull the trigger.

UNLOADING YOUR NOMAD SINGLE BARREL SHOTGUN



To unload your Nomad single barrel shotgun make sure the hammer is in the full forward uncocked position then simply pull back on the trigger guard ratate the barrel downward to expose the cartridge the guns automatic extractor will push the shell out of the barrel's firing chamber so that it can be easily

WARNING: In case of a misfire, keep the firearm pointed in a safe direction and wait one minute before opening firearm.



Firearm Safety

1. Read and understand the owner's manual before using the firearm. 2. If you are unfamiliar with firearms, attend a firearms safety class taught by a certified instructor.

3. Handle every firearm as if it were loaded and ready to fire.

4. Control the muzzle, and never point a firearm at anything you don't want to shoot.

5. Keep the hammer in the full forward uncock position until you are ready to shoot

6. Unless you are hunting, carry your firearm empty, with the action open.7. Before shooting, be sure you have an adequate backstop. All ammunition is dangerous beyond your line of sight.

8. Avoid ricochets by never shooting at water or any hard, flat surface.
9. Do not run, climb, or jump over an obstacle with a loaded firearm.
10. Do not climb into or out of a tree or tree stand with a loaded firearm.

Do not allow others to pass loaded firearms to you while in a tree stand.

11. Do not enter or ride in a motor vehicle with loaded firearms.

12. Do not lean a loaded firearm against anything.

13. Do not bump, drop or jar a loaded firearm.

14. Do not pull a firearm toward you by the muzzle.

15. Wear hearing protectors when shooting.

16.Wear impact-protective glasses when shooting, disassembling or cleaning firearms.

17.Avoid alcoholic beverages and drugs before and during shooting. 18. Use only ammunition of the correct gauge, caliber, size and bullet shape for your firearm.

19. Do not use damaged, dirty, modified, or improperly handloaded ammunition.

20. Keep the barrel and mechanism of the firearm free of obstructions. 21. Do not use a firearm that fails to function properly. Do not try to force a jammed action.


22. Be sure no one is in the path of ejecting shells or cartridges.


23. Do not interchange parts between firearms, and be sure disassembly and reassembly are correct and complete.

24. Before cleaning, be sure the chamber, action and magazine are completely unloaded.


25. Unload firearms before storing, transporting, or leaving unattended. 26. Store firearms and ammunition separately, locked and out of the reach of children.



What is not covered under warranty?

We will not cover damage of your firearm caused by:

- · Failure to provide proper care and maintenance
- Accidents, abuse or misuse
- Barrel obstruction
- · Hand loaded, reloaded or improper ammunition
- Unauthorized adjustments, repairs or modifications
- · Normal wear and tear

What is excluded from this warranty?

American Tactical excludes and will not pay incidental or consequential damages under this warranty. By this we mean any loss, expense or damages other than to repair defects in the firearm or replace the firearm. No implied warranties extend beyond the term of this written warranty.

SERVICES OUTSIDE OF WARRANTY COVERAGE:

Any firearms requiring service outside of the scope of manufacturer warranty require a minimum \$25 shipping and handling fee for return shipping expenses. This fee must be paid prior to issuance of a RA from Customer Service. It is the responsibility of the owner of the firearm to pay shipping expenses incurred for the firearm to return to American Tactical's facility.

Once inspected, you will receive a service quote for the cost of parts and labor for any fees required to service the firearm. No service work will be performed without authorization following issuance of the quote. Should the service quote be accepted, all fees must be paid prior to return of the firearm to the customer. Should the service quote be refused, no work will be performed and firearm will be returned to the customer in the condition in which it was received. If no response to an issued quote is received by American Tactical within 30 days of issuance, the firearm will be returned to the customer in the condition in which it was received.
