Instructions

 Safety - All SOG assisted opening knives have a built-in safety. It is designed to give extra protection against accidental blade opening when carried (in your pocket, for example).
See info below for operating specific models.

Aegis - The safety switch is on the side of the handle, towards the back of the knife. To open the blade, make sure the safety is down and shows red. It is now ready to open. When you want to keep the blade locked within the handle, just push the button up to engage the safety. When the safety is on the button will show green.



Flash and Trident - The safety switch is on the side of the handle, towards the back of the knife. To open the blade, make sure the safety is up so the button shows red. It is now ready to open. When you want to keep the blade locked within the handle, just push the button down to engage the safety.

- Blink, Twitch, and SlimJim The safety is on the top of the handle, towards the back/spine. To open the blade, make sure the safety is pushed towards the back end of the handle. To engage the safety, push it towards the locking bar.
- Pocket Clip If the pocket clip is reversible, it is best to change the clip to the opposite side from which your thumb will be opening the blade. This will give your fingers a better hold on the handle.
- 3. Opening the Blade Start to open the blade using the thumb stud or blade kick. At about 15 degrees of movement S.A.T. will take over to complete opening and lock the blade in the open position.

It might take a little practice to get comfortable with the grasping and opening of your new knife. If the blade is not opening fully, you might be holding your thumb on the thumb stud too long or blocking the opening blade with one

of your other fingers. It is best to push the blade

open with your thumb behind the thumb stud...

not on top of it.

NOTE: FOR YOUR SAFETY, IT IS IMPORTANT THAT YOU KEEP YOUR OTHER HAND AWAY FROM THE BI ADE WHILE OPENING 4. Closing the Blade - To close the blade on the Aegis, Trident and Flash pull back the button on the Arc-Actuator, located on the side of the knife near the pivot, and rotate the blade closed with two hands. The blade is now securely inside the handle. If you want extra security push the safety to the locked position.

To close the blade on the Twitch, push on the lockbar and rotate the blade closed with two hands. The blade is now held securely inside the handle. To lock the blade closed, just slide the safety into the locked position.

NOTE: BE SURE TO ALWAYS KEEP YOUR FINGERS CLEAR WHEN CLOSING ANY KNIFE BLADE.

5. Groove (Trident Only) - When using the Groove™ in the handle the blade needs to be in the closed and locked position with safety on. To cut cord or webbing, simply pull the material through the Groove in the handle allowing the blade to cut material. For best results the material being cut should be under tension.

General Maintenance

Your knife is made from the finest stainless steel. All stainless steels can rust under certain conditions. Below is some information to help you get the most of your knife.

- After becoming dirty, or after exposure to salt water, perspiration, or chemicals, rinse the product with fresh water, dry completely, and use a high-quality petroleum-based lubricant or anti-rusting agent on all metal surfaces.
- While it is not in use, keep stored in a dry area outside of the sheath to help prevent rust.
- Should rust appear, use a light steel wool pad (000 grit) to buff off rust, then reapply antirusting agent.
- Never store your knife in a wet sheath. Never store your knife in a leather case for long periods, as leather-tanning acids might accelerate rusting.
