

After removing the original stock and forend, begin by aligning the grip and tube as seen in (Figure 1a) to the receiver as seen in (Figure 1b). Next, using the provided bolt (1) and the appropriate socket wrench, tighten the grip to the receiver as seen in (Figure 1c).

To install the buttstock onto the tube, begin by grabbing the adjustment lever with your thumb and index finger and pulling down as seen in (Figure 2a). While holding the adjustment lever down, begin to slide the stock onto the tube as seen in Figure 2b) until seated as seen in (Figure 2c).

To install the sling stud (3) choose which hole on the bottom of the forend you would like to install it to and using an open face wrench

To install the Shotforce, begin by aligning the rear of the forend with the front ot the receiver as seen in (Figure 3a) and then pivoting the forend upwards until seated as seen in (Figure 3b).
