

02 OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS AND CARE

This rifle was designed from high grade ordnance steel to handle the new caliber .22TCM cartridge, developed and manufactured by Armscor Global Defense, Inc. This rifle is packed and shipped from the factory with detached bolt assembly.

TO INSERT BOLT INTO RECEIVER

Cock the bolt assembly by gripping the bolt firmly and rotating the cocking cam counter clockwise. Move safety to "F" position. Align the lug underneath the bolt assembly with the receiver track. Slide the cocked bolt assembly into the receiver, push it fully forward and turn the cocking cam clockwise until its top and bottom lugs are properly seated.

TO LOAD MAGAZINE BOX

Hold magazine firmly in one hand. With the other hand, position cartridge over magazine lip just forward of notch. Insert cartridge head under ears at rear of magazine. Repeat until five cartridges are loaded.

TO MAKE SAFE

Pull safety on right side of the receiver in the direction of the "S" mark. This locks trigger and gun cannot be fired.

TO ATTACH MAGAZINE BOX

Positionmagazine open end up and ears rearward. Insert magazine into the opening forward of the trigger guard. Push magazine inward until it engages with the magazine release in its slot locking in place.

TO REMOVE MAGAZINE BOX

To disengage magazine, press magazine release, hold on lock and pull box downward and out.

TO OPEN ACTION

Hold bolt handle and rotate cocking cam counter clockwise. As soon as he lugsclear the lug seat, pull bolt handle fully rearward.

TO CLOSE ACTION

Push bolt handle fully forward and rotate cocking cam clockwise until lugs are properly seated.

TO FIRE

BE SURE THAT RIFLE IS POINTED ATTARGET! With action closed, move safety to "F" position. Pull trigger. To repeat, open and close action. The discharged shell will be ejected and a new cartridge will be fed into the chamber. Pull trigger. Repeat process as desired until magazine is empty.

TO LOAD FOR SINGLE SHOT

Open action. Insert cartridge directly into chamber with empty magazine in place

IMPORTANT: CAL.22 TCM is a neck rifle style cartridge which uses a slower burning powder. When fired, some powder residues are left behind. Thus, cleaning the gun after around 300 rounds fired is highly recommended as keeping the chamber clean is much more critical on this type of ammunition.

FOR SHORT STORAGE

After firing, swab bore with clean cloth patch wet with approved cleaning solvent. Wipe dry. Apply light coat of oil on barrel bore, cocking cam, bolt and other metal surfaces to keen free of rust.

FOR LONG STORAGE

After firing, swab bore with clean cloth patch wet with approved cleaning solvent. Wipe dry, Apply a good grade of gun grease or gun oil on the bore and other outside metal surfaces. Before firing after storage, remove all traces of gun grease or gun oil from barrel bore. CHECK THAT BORE IS FREE OF ANY OBSTRUCTION! Obstruction will block passage of bullet and may cause injury to barrel or person.

04 SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

Safety must be the first and constant consideration of every person who handles firearms and ammunition. The person with a firearm in his possession has an important responsibility. He/she must know how to use his/her firearm safely:

- 1. Always keep the firearm holstered except when drawn for a definite purpose.
- 2. Always check the firearm for live ammunition when picked up, drawn from the holster, handed to, or received from another person.
- 3. Never point the firearm at anything you do not intend to shoot.
- 4. Never cock the hammer of the firearm unless you are ready to immediately shoot it. Do not even insert your finger in the trigger guard until you are ready to shoot.
- 5. Avoid dry firing even with dummy cartridges, unless the same is performed on a regular target range or at a known inanimate target.
- 6. When holding the firearm that is ready to fire, be absolutely certain that it is not pointed at any part of your body or at any person within your immediate vicinity.
- 7. Beware of obstructions in barrel. If, when firing, a weak or peculiar report is heard, cease firing and inspect the barrel for an obstruction. Remove magazine then check to insure there is no obstruction in barrel or chamber.
- 8. When a misfire or a "dud" is experienced keep the rifle pointed at the target for at least ten seconds before inspecting the firearm.
- A delayed firing may occur.
- 9. Remove magazine and ensure chamber and barrel are free of foreign objects.
- 10. When possible, wear shooting glasses and hearing protectors when firing.
- 11. Do not shoot at a hard surface, or water for the bullet can glance off and travel in unpredictable directions with considerable velocity.
- 12. Avoid drinking alcoholic beverages when handling the firearm.






08 EXPLODED DRAWING

STORAGE AND TRANSPORTATION

When storing the firearm and ammunition, store in separate locations, store ammo in a cool, dry location. When storing the gun for a prolonged period of time, it is necessary to oil it heavily with an acid-free lubricant. The external parts must be coated with an anti-rust oil or grease to prevent moisture causing the parts to rust and malfunction.

Before usage, the rifle must be cleaned and wiped dry again as discussed previously.
